Data from the FS-1 can be loaded into your computer for storage and analysis. An optional heart rate monitor is also available. Coach Dave Camire currently has a highly favorable review of the FS-1 posted on his Cool Running web site: www.coolrunning.com. Fit-Sense will give Striders a 20% discount on the FS-1 and accessories. plus return 10% back to the Striders treasury.
