

# **Gate City Strider Scholarship**

The Gate City Striders running club is offering a scholarship to high school or college students who are members of, or whose parents are members of GCS, or GCS members may also sponsor eligible non-member students.

#### **Scholarship Information**

- The GCS Scholarship is a non-renewable award.
- Applicants must have applied and been accepted at a college, university or vocational school at the time of the scholarship is awarded.
- Receiving the award does not preclude the applicant from applying for and accepting other scholarships, loans, grants or other aid.
- Applicant need not participate in college athletics.
- Recipients will be notified by e-mail no later than June 12<sup>th</sup>.
- Application forms can be downloaded from the GCS web site (www.gatecity.org).

## Eligibility

- Must be either a Strider, a child of a Strider or nominated by a Strider who has been active with the club for more than one year.
- Must have been accepted at a college, university or vocational school.
- Previous GCS Scholarship winners are <u>not</u> eligible.

#### Requirements

- Completed and signed application form (page 2 of this document).
- Copy of transcripts
- Two letters of recommendation or two references
- Typed essay (one page maximum) on the following topic: "What running means to me-past, present, and future".
- List any GCS activities in which you (the applicant) and/or your family or sponsor have participated (volunteering, racing, social, etc).

#### **Selection Criteria**

The selection criteria will be established by the Scholarship Committee.


#### **Application Deadline**
